

Water Is Life

Clean, safe water is essential for survival. Yet it is a luxury in many parts of the world.

You are helping improve access to safe drinking water in communities like Luisiana, Philippines. Before Americas and our partners began working in this area, families struggled with obtaining enough clean water for drinking and hygiene. Your support helped construct a storage tank to service the entire community, remove contaminants from well water and improve handwashing techniques among residents at a local health center.

Funding Cuts Hurt The Most Vulnerable

We know the real-life consequences of the funding cuts that occurred earlier this year. These budget lines aren't just numbers on a page—they're people like Moisés.

Born with cerebral palsy in Venezuela, Moisés has faced enormous challenges throughout his life. When Moisés and his family fled to neighboring Colombia to escape political violence and economic upheaval in their home country, the young man was able to receive medicine and therapies for his cerebral palsy at an Americas clinic in Puerto Carreño, Colombia. But U.S. government funding cuts forced the clinic to close—leaving Moisés with nowhere to go for the treatment he needed.

That is when you and other members of the Americas community stepped up. An incredible outpouring of generosity allowed the clinic to temporarily reopen, enabling Moisés to once again receive care at no cost to his family.

This was a great relief for Moisés and his mother, Joanna, whose love and courage, combined with your support, have helped put him on a path toward a healthier future. Thank you for helping to fill the dangerous gap left by government funding cuts so people in need don't fall through the cracks. ❤️

Emergency Response Snapshot

You help Americares respond immediately when natural disasters, humanitarian crises caused by war, poverty and disease imperil people close to home and around the world.



← **LOS ANGELES:** This year began with massive wildfires destroying more than 16,000 structures, including homes, in Los Angeles County. Your generosity enabled Americares to provide medicines, relief supplies, water, mental health support and cash assistance to people who lost their homes or income because of the fires.



← **GAZA:** Ongoing hostilities have displaced more than 90 percent of the population of Gaza. Americares is working with partner organizations to increase access to medicine and medical supplies. Americares has delivered 35 tons of aid to date and if border access improves, we can quickly mobilize more shipments.



← **CENTRAL TEXAS:** Deadly floods swept through Central Texas, causing unimaginable devastation and loss of life. Americares contacted partner clinics in the affected areas to offer assistance and then sent an emergency response team to Kerrville to meet with local partners and assess urgent health needs, including mental health support.



← **MYANMAR:** A powerful earthquake struck Myanmar in March, destroying communities, leaving thousands buried under rubble and overwhelming medical facilities. Americares deployed an emergency response team to the region to support mobile medical teams treating survivors and used emergency funding to increase access to clean water and sanitation.
